In consideration of the signing of this Corporate Agreement, the following is agreed:

1. Objective

The objective of this corporate agreement is to establish a collaboration between ISAM and BGU, in the educational and corporate field with the aim of granting special discounts to the employees of ISAM in the programs offered by BGU for their specialization and professional growth.

2. Scope of corporate benefits



BGU agrees to grant a special discount of 50% on tuition fees for any academic program offered by BGU to the employees of the ISAM. This discount is applicable only to active employees who have been with ISAM for 12 months.

3. Procedure to access corporate benefits

- 3.1. BGU will provide ISAM with the necessary information about eligible programs for the corporate discount, as well as the procedures for ISAM's employees to access such discount.
- 3.2. ISAM is committed to actively promote BGU's programs among its employees, highlighting the special discounts offered under this agreement. BGU will provide ISAM with promotional materials and any relevant information necessary to facilitate such promotion.
- 3.3. ISAM undertakes to timely and accurately communicate to its employees about the existence of the corporate discount, eligible programs and the steps to follow to access said discount.
- 3.4. ISAM commits to deducting the amount from its employees' payroll and transferring it to BGU.

4. Modifications and Termination

- 4.1. This agreement may be modified or amended with the mutual written consent and signature by both parties.
- 4.2. This agreement will be valid for 12 months from the date of its subscription.
- 4.3. Either party may terminate this agreement by providing written notice six months advance notice prior to the termination date.
- 4.4. The termination of this agreement will not affect the participation in the programs of those ISAM employees who have been fully or conditionally admitted to the BGU.

5. Confidentiality

- 5.1. The parties commit to maintain the confidentiality of any sensitive or strategic information shared under this agreement. This confidentiality obligation will persist even after the termination of this agreement.

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Articulation Agreement (the "Agreement") is to establish a collaboration between BGU and IES Privado "Sabio Nacional Antúnez de Mayolo" (ISAM) in an effort to facilitate the transfer and degree completion of students obtaining a Título Profesional Técnico in Administración de Empresas, Contabilidad, Desarrollo de Sistemas de Información, Administración de Negocios Bancarios y Financieros, Administración de Negocios Internacionales, Administración de Plataformas y Servicios Web, Gestión de Recursos Humanos y Marketing at Sabio Nacional Antúnez de Mayolo (ISAM) towards the *Bachelor of Science in Business Administration* at BGU.

This Agreement also serves as a Memorandum of Understanding between both institutions for the purpose of clarifying roles and responsibilities in this partnership.

II. GUIDING PRINCIPLES

In consideration of the mutual arrangements and conditions expressed herein, the parties agree to the following:

A. General Requirements

1. All courses meeting general education requirements at IES Privado "Sabio Nacional Antúnez de Mayolo" (ISAM) will transfer and be applied towards the undergraduate general education requirements at BGU.
2. A maximum of 60 credits will transfer from IES Privado "Sabio Nacional Antúnez de Mayolo" (ISAM).
3. Upon enrolling to BGU, IES Privado "Sabio Nacional Antúnez de Mayolo" (ISAM) students must satisfy all general education, graduation and major requirements as outlined in the BGU Catalog.
4. IES Privado "Sabio Nacional Antúnez de Mayolo" (ISAM) students must take a minimum of 60 credit at BGU to earn a *Bachelor of Science in Business Administration* degree. The final 60 credits must be earned at BGU.
5. BGU requires a minimum of 60 to attain a Bachelor degree.

B. Advising/ Academic Planning

1. Students should work closely with their academic advisor at IES Privado "Sabio Nacional Antúnez de Mayolo" (ISAM) to develop an academic plan to ensure a seamless transition.
2. Students and advisors are encouraged to utilize a variety of advising resources, including the BGU and IES Privado "Sabio Nacional Antúnez de Mayolo" (ISAM) catalogs and syllabi, to ascertain transferability of coursework.
3. Following admission to BGU, students will receive an evaluation of prior college coursework. This evaluation will include a Transfer Credit Report and a Degree Audit detailing prior coursework, transferability and applicability to BGU general and university requirements.
4. Prior to matriculation to BGU, all new students are required to attend the mandatory new student orientation program. During orientation, students will meet and hear from



academic advisors to review its prior coursework, discuss academic interests and goals, and develop an academic plan.

5. Upon matriculation, students will be assigned an advisor in their area of study. Students are strongly encouraged to meet with their advisor periodically. Students are required to meet with their advisor prior to registering for subsequent semesters.

C. Admissions

1. The BGU Registrar Office evaluates transfer applicants on the basis of their academic record at previous institutions. Cumulative grade point average, performance trends, strength of curriculum and performance in courses related to the intended area of study are considered.
2. Applicants successfully completing the articulated program with a 2.0 or better grade point average who have not subsequently matriculated at any other institution of higher education will be guaranteed transfer admission to BGU. A student with a history of acts identified under the institutional student conduct code may disqualify a candidate for guaranteed admission.

D. Scholarships and Financial Aid

1. Students transferring from IES Privado "Sabio Nacional Antúnez de Mayolo" (ISAM) to BGU who meet application deadlines, academic and financial qualification that apply to all students, may be eligible for consideration for the following scholarships offered by BGU:
 - 1.1. "Elizabeth Blackwell" Grant
 - 1.2. "One" Scholarship
2. To maximize consideration for need-based aid, students are encouraged to complete the BGU grant application form or the BGU scholarship application form.

E. Ongoing Collaboration

1. In the spirit of articulation, faculty representatives from both institutions may meet regularly to engage in ongoing discussion in order to enhance and strengthen this collaboration.
2. BGU *Academic Affairs* faculty may serve as a resource, as available, to IES Privado "Sabio Nacional Antúnez de Mayolo" (ISAM), *Oficina Central – EFSRT y convenios* students and faculty by serving as guest lecturers, workshop/seminar facilitators and other program exchanges.
3. Partner institutions agree to communicate program changes in a timely manner to avoid disruption to student progress toward degree completion.


